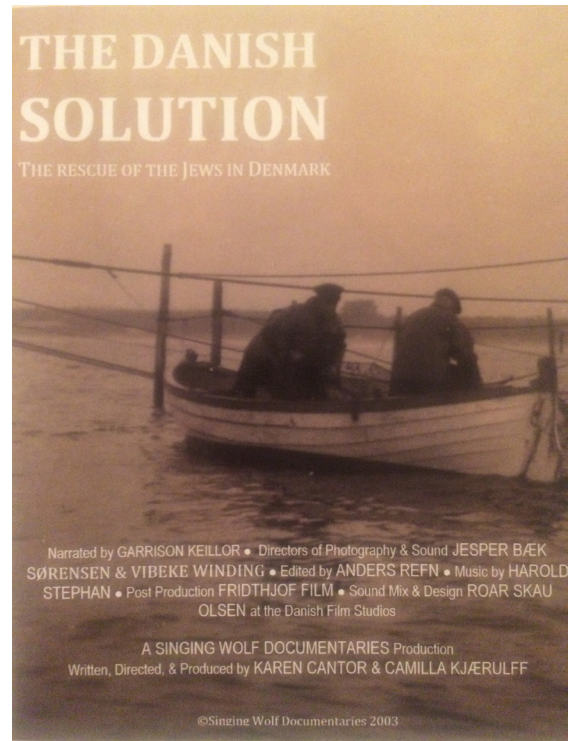
As always for the shared lunch we will provide rye bread, butter and various condiments - you bring the toppings! The bar will be open, and there will also be coffee/tea.
